The reader will find a host of information in this graph.

Various patterns can be discerned and the frequency in which particular Haftorahs are read are easily seen.

It covers the years 5740 through 5810, a 70 year stretch.

Erev Rosh Chodesh, Rosh Chodesh and special Haftorah's are noted. Interesting patterns can be noted here, as well.

KEY

Leap years are noted between double lines and are speckled

Shmita years are gray-scaled & noted at the top of the first and bottom of the last page

x = regular haftorah

rc = Rosh Chodesh outlined in a dark box

e = erev Rosh Chodesh

Rosh chodesh when a special haftorah is recited will be in a dark outlined cell

Erev rosh chodesh when a special haftorah is said will have a double underline

M = Purim Mukafim in Yerushalayim

sh = Parshas Shekalim


p = Parshas Parah

<p>Rosh Chodesh can only occur on 13 Shabbasos</p> <p>Erev Rosh Chodesh can only fall on 8 Shabbasos</p> <p>All of the 4 Parshiose; Shekalim, Parah, Zachor and HaChodesh can only fall on 3 different Shabbasos each except Parah which can fall on 4</p> <p>Of the seven double Parshios the one read together most frequently is</p> <p>The double Parsha read together least frequently is</p> <p>Parshas Mishpatim and Shmini can have the most, 4, different Haftorose read</p> <p>The regular Haftorah is read for Miketz the fewest times as it is usually Chanuka</p> <p>Purim Mukafim occurred in Yerushalayim only</p> <p>No double Parshiose layned in ???</p>
